

**Camp Pack List**  
**Last updated June 2010**

Toilet Gear	Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, towel
Eating Gear	Knife, fork, spoon Unbreakable plate, cup, bowl
Dilly Bag	A cloth bag with draw string to hold dishes. Cloth allows the dishes to dry while hanging.
Sleeping Gear	Sleeping mat/ mattress, sleeping bag, pillow (optional)
Clothes	2 changes of warm clothes, jumper, 2 pairs underwear, 3 pairs socks (you always need extra socks) For wet weather waterproof your pack or pack your clothes in plastic bags.
Rain Jacket	
Shoes	Spare old shoes or hiking boots
Day Pack	Basic back-pack for day hike
	Water bottle, personal 1 <sup>st</sup> aid kit (optional), whistle (optional)
Sun Gear	Hat, sunscreen – for winter bring beanie
Torch	Headlight or hand torch – make sure it works.
Pocket knife	Only if your PL has approved your knife permit. Locking blades only.
Campfire Blanket	Optional, but good for cold weather
