### WHAT DO I BRING

| <u>Clothing</u>  | Hat<br><b>Complete Uniform</b> (including closed-in footwear)<br>2 pair's shorts<br>2 Tee shirts including Group T-shirt<br>Jeans, long pants or tracksuit pants<br>3 Pairs of socks<br>3 changes of underwear<br>Jumper or jacket<br>Closed in shoes (NO THONGS)<br>PJs or something to sleep in<br>Wet Weather Gear ie raincoat or poncho (if weather requires) |
| <u>Toiletries</u>  | In one bag - Soap, Toothbrush and paste, Comb/brush   |
| <u>Bedding</u>   | Bed Roll with Sleeping bag & pillow<br>Blanket<br>Airbed or sleeping mat (NO STRETCHERS OR SWAGS)   |
| <u>Eating</u>  | Dilly Bag (Cotton type not plastic)<br>1 unbreakable plate, sweet/cereal bowl, & mug<br>Knife, fork, dessert spoon  |
| <u>Miscellaneous</u>                                       | <b>YELLOW BADGE BOOK</b><br>Drink bottle - full (at least 500ml)<br>Insect Repellent<br>Sun Block<br>Personal First Aid Kit/Survival Kit<br>plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes<br>Camera (optional)<br><u>Coat Hanger for Uniform</u><br>Small torch and spare batteries<br>Small cuddly/fluffy/bedtime toy  |
